Sweater Finishing Basics

No matter how beautifully you can knit a sweater, it isn't done until it's "finished." We're offering two classes that will give you the skills that make your knitted projects look hand crafted, not homemade. Learn how to give a garment structure and polish.

Seaming (1 session): In the Seaming class, we'll cover how to work side seams that disappear into the garment, shoulder seams that help the garment hang right, and tips for end weaves that stay woven. Homework required.

Seaming: Feb. 10

Blocking and Picking Up Stitches (1 session): In the Blocking and Picking Up Stitches class, you'll learn two critical skills for a successful sweater. In the first half of the 3 hour class, you'll learn how to properly block your swatches (critical for determining gauge!) as well as how to block your sweater to size. In the second half, you'll learn how to pick up stitches for necklines and button bands that lie flat. Homework required. Registered students will receive 15% off of a CocoKnits blocking kit!

Fixing Mistakes


You can knit and purl, but what do you do when you make a mistake? In this class we will review how to fix common knitting mistakes. Bring a swatch in worsted weight yarn: 20 sts wide and 20 rows in stockinette (knit 1 row, purl 1 row), on a size 10 needle with a J crochet hook.
